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1. IQAC quality check mechanism -(Internal Quality Assurance Cell) / College Development Committee check mechanism

<u>Internal Quality Assurance Cell</u> is an important mechanism for ensuring quality in higher education institutions, including architecture colleges. The IQAC cell was established on 23.02.2023 in A.B.College of Architecture, Sangli.

Before IQAC, the institute development plans were followed up by the College Development Committee.

The College Development Committee (CDC) is responsible for the overall development of A.B.College of Architecture, Sangli.(ABCA,Sangli) In ABCA,

the CDC has the following check mechanisms:

1. Curriculum Development:

The CDC oversees the development of the curriculum for the architecture program. They ensure that the curriculum is up-to-date, relevant, and meets the industry standards. The CDC reviews the course content, delivery methods, and teaching materials.

2. Faculty Development:

The CDC also oversees the professional development of faculty members. This includes organizing workshops, seminars, and training sessions to update the skills of the faculty members. The CDC also reviews the performance of the faculty members and provides feedback.
